TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2007 SPRINTER COPPER CANYON. THE CONTACT STATED THAT THE AIR VALVES IN 3 OF THE 4 TIRES ALLOWED AIR TO LEAK OUT OF THE TIRES. HE LOST APPROXIMATELY 30 LBS OF AIR EACH DAY DUE TO THE DEFECTIVE TIRE VALVES. HE TOOK THE TRAILER TO A TIRE SHOP TO HAVE THE VALVES EXCHANGED FOR NEW ONES. HE DISCOVERED A RELEVANT RECALL IN A MAGAZINE; HOWEVER, HIS MODEL WAS NOT INCLUDED. THE MANUFACTURER HAS NOT BEEN NOTIFIED. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS NOT APPLICABLE. 30 LBS.
