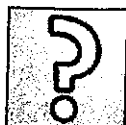

We've had our Versa for almost 2 years. Within the first 8 months, we lost a hubcap. No biggie, we replaced it. Three weeks later we lost another one. Nissan said it wasn't covered under the warranty! We've replaced a total of four BROKEN hubcaps (2 on the back passenger side fell off) and now a 5th one is ready to come off! The clips break & they don't go back on, except for the 2 that the center fell out and the ring stayed attached to the tire! Nissan says it's not a design flaw! Whatever!!! I've been driving for 20 years and prior to owning the Versa, I lost ONE hubcap after I had a tire changed & it wasn't put back on properly. But at least it didn't break, it went back on the car!

Favorite Features

We love the interior space, it is great for our family of four.

Suggested Improvements

Improve the hubcaps, weather stripping around the door, had CD player replaced twice, bumpers are not attached securely, and needs better speakers. Nissan should at least look into the issue with the hubcaps, we've seen several of Versas that have missing hubcaps too!

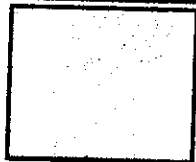

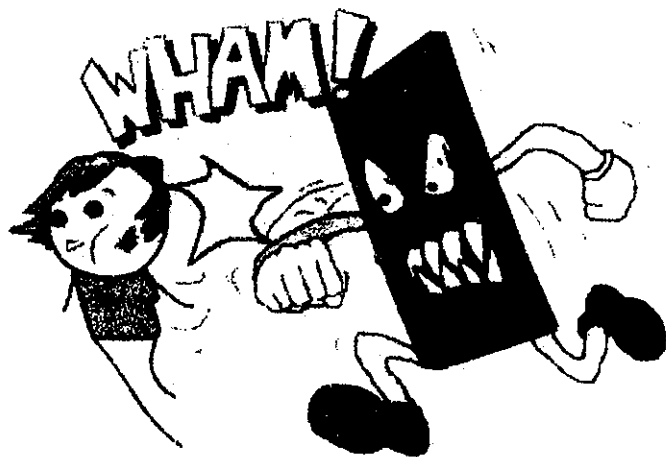

Silicone will bond to most anything, just make sure its clean not dirty like applying any other thing, I did not say squirt the entire your wheels, Just a little on the tabs of the hub caps, you can still pull them off later, Unless you emptied the complete tube of si any one knows not to do. LOL

Oh and Nissantech you will probably discover what silicone is all about through the years working on nissans, I found it stuck to plastic, /glass/paper/rubber/cylinder heads/spark plug wires/caps. sealing leaks valve covers/carbs. gasket making, well i could g most anything like i said. Have you ever used ATV silicone/gasket ??
