TL*THE CONTACT HAS A 2007 JAGUAR X-TYPE. THE CONTACT STATED THAT THE VEHICLE ACCELERATES UNEXPECTEDLY WHILE IDLING. AT THE TIME OF THE FAILURE, THE RPM'S DRAMATICALLY INCREASE, BUT THE WARNING INDICATORS WERE NOT ILLUMINATED ON THE INSTRUMENT PANEL. THE CONTACT HAD TO PLACE THE VEHICLE INTO NEUTRAL TO PREVENT IT FROM MOVING. THE RISK OF A SERIOUS CRASH WAS INCREASED. THE MANUFACTURER STATED THAT THE CAUSE OF THE FAILURE WAS UNKNOWN AND THERE WAS NO CURRENT REMEDY. THE FAILURE AND CURRENT MILEAGES WERE 32,390. *Problem occurred while stopped with brake applied, and selector in 'D'.*
The X type was provided by Jaguar from Enterprise while my S type '05 was in shop at Moore. Jaguar Auto had a DSC System Fault but Enterprise said Moore said O.K. to drive.

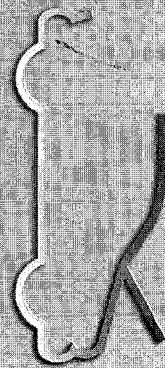
