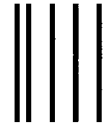

This has been a problem for years with these windows. Cheapest price to fix is approx \$208 per window. We almost had a wreck on the interstate because the visibility is so poor on the Drivers side window. The manufacturer of the RV has also been aware of this for years. Traveling at 60 MPH in a 40' motorhome on the highway is a very dangerous accident waiting to happen.

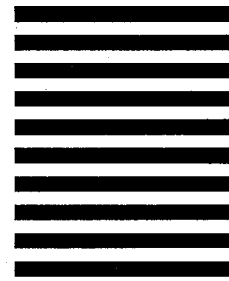

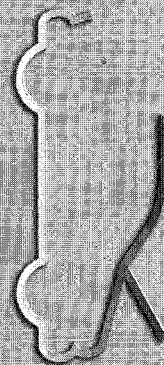
