Thank you for your correspondence dated September 18, 2009, on behalf of your client [REDACTED]. You wrote concerning [REDACTED] model year (MY) 2008 Victory Vision Tour motorcycle. Your correspondence was received by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) Office of Defects Investigation on October 6, 2009.

NHTSA is the Federal agency responsible for improving safety on our Nation's highways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or items of motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain safety defects in their design, construction, or performance. In order for the agency to initiate an investigation, we look carefully at the body of consumer complaints and other available data to determine whether a safety defect may exist. We cannot act on isolated problems or resolve disputes between individual owners, dealers, or manufacturers.

We appreciate the report you provided. Reports from motorists are a very important source of information for us. In your letter you indicate the position of the tip-over protectors can result in the rider's feet to become pinned beneath the motorcycle causing injury. We have reviewed our database in an effort to identify whether a safety defect trend exists with regard to the position of the tip-over protectors in MY 2008 Victory Vision Tour motorcycles. Although we are not opening an investigation at this time, we continually review all available data to determine whether an investigation may be warranted. A brochure explaining the investigation process is enclosed for your information. The information you provided on behalf of [REDACTED] has been entered into our database and will be considered with future reports to identify any safety defect trends that may require our attention.
