Our Unit has the following Problems

1. The UNIT - TRANSMISSION DOESN'T ALWAYS SHIFT INTO a
higher gear when it should.
2. Some times very slow to respond to foot-feed AS needed.
AND slowly decreases speed traveled.
3. Engine has lost ALL power AND loss of control
while driving @ highway speed, Causing personal
AND traffic problems.
4. TRANSMISSION WOULD NOT SHIFT from Lower gears.
wouldn't travel faster than 15 miles per Hour.
5. Brakes replaced twice in first 15,000. miles
ON Speedometer. Metal filings IN PAD, worn rotors.
