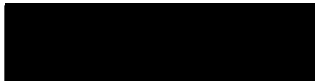

Thank you for your correspondence dated December 2, 2009, concerning your model year (MY) 2002 Hummer H1 vehicles. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) Office of Defects Investigation received your correspondence on December 4, 2009.

NHTSA is the Federal agency responsible for improving safety on our Nation's highways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or items of motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain safety defects in their design, construction, or performance. However, we cannot act on isolated problems or resolve disputes between individual owners, dealers, or manufacturers.

We appreciate the report you provided. Reports from motorists are a very important source of information for us. Each report is analyzed and entered into a database to determine whether an investigation into a possible safety defect or safety defect recall adequacy is warranted.

In your letter you indicate that you experienced sudden acceleration in your MY 2002 Hummer H1 due to a defective AC Delco accelerator pedal (Part Number 213-2820) which you replaced 3 times. A review of our database relative to problems associated with sudden acceleration in MY 2002 Hummer H1 vehicles when a AC Delco accelerator pedal is used as a repair part revealed no reports similar to that which you encountered; there is insufficient evidence to warrant opening a safety investigation at this time. We are sorry you experienced this problem and suggest you work with General Motors and AC Delco for a solution. The information you provided has been entered into our database. It will be considered with future reports to identify any safety defect trends that may require our attention.
