TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2004 JEEP GRAND CHEROKEE. WHILE DRIVING, SHE TURNED ON THE AIR CONDITIONER AND SMOKE STARTED COMING FROM UNDER THE PASSENGER SIDE FLOOR BOARD; NEAR THE AIR VENTS. THE FIRE DEPARTMENT EXTINGUISHED THE FIRE. THE CAUSE OF THE FAILURE HAS NOT BEEN DETERMINED. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 67,000. Smoke came out of air vents after I turned on the air conditioner. I couldn't breathe so I put the windows down and pulled over in the Mall parking lot. I couldn't got out and it was so smokey I couldn't reach in to get my purse in the passenger seat so I walked around + opened the door to get purse + then saw fire coming through the passenger floorboard.
