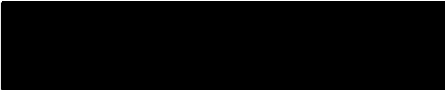

Again, I was lucky that I did not lose my life, but others may not be so lucky.

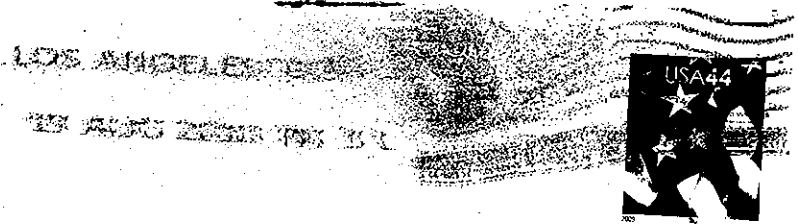
