Defective brake light switch

I have just had the brake light switch replaced on my 2006 Honda Civic. I became aware of a problem when, on multiple occasions, I could not shift out of "park" and into gear. My mechanic informed me that, in addition to the problem I noticed, I would have been without brake lights, at least sporadically, for the past several weeks, thus being at risk for being struck in the rear.

I understand that Honda issued a recall for 2006 Civics for this exact problem (NHTSA # 07V402000; Honda recall # Q58), but that the recall did not include my vehicle. (According to the VIN, it was manufactured before vehicles included in the recall.)

The intent of this letter is to notify you that the problem addressed in the recall notice applies to more vehicles than just those included in the recall notice.
