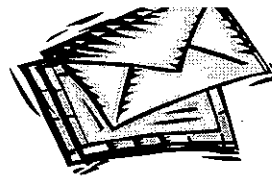

I never received a word from them and again sent a request for information on my complaint I believe 12/10. To date I have not received any word or even a drop dead from them. As a note my vehicle was manufactured 01/01/89. If you can help on this matter, I would appreciate it.</MSG>
