I had informed you, of an acceleration problem, that I occasionally had with my 2007 Toyota Corolla & Toyota would not acknowledge the problem.

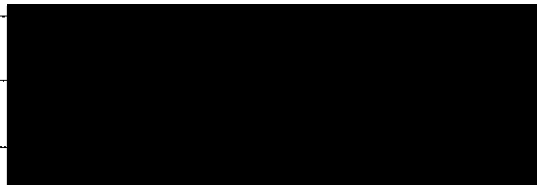
