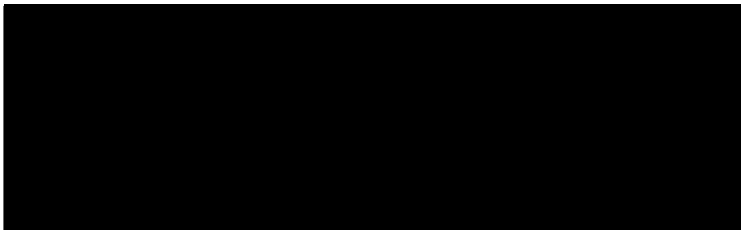
Dear Chief Randy Reid:

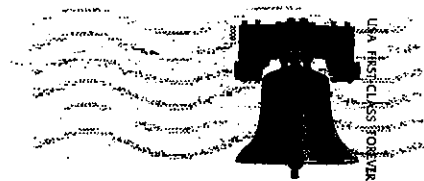
