

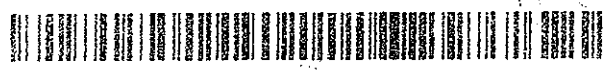

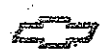
As the owner of a 2002 model year Chevrolet TrailBlazer, your satisfaction with our product is very important to us.

This letter is intended to make you aware that on some 2002 model year Chevrolet TrailBlazer vehicles operated in one of the corrosion areas listed below, the fuel tank modular reservoir assembly, which contains the fuel pump, may develop corrosion of the fuel feed/return pipes after an extended period of time. Severe corrosion may cause the formation of small perforations. These perforations may allow a small amount of fuel to accumulate in a recessed area outside of the fuel tank. If this were to occur, it would be accompanied by a fuel odor. If left uncorrected and the corrosion is allowed to progress, a fuel spray from the pipes may begin to occur.

Do not take your vehicle to your Chevrolet dealer as a result of this letter unless you believe that your vehicle has the condition as described above.

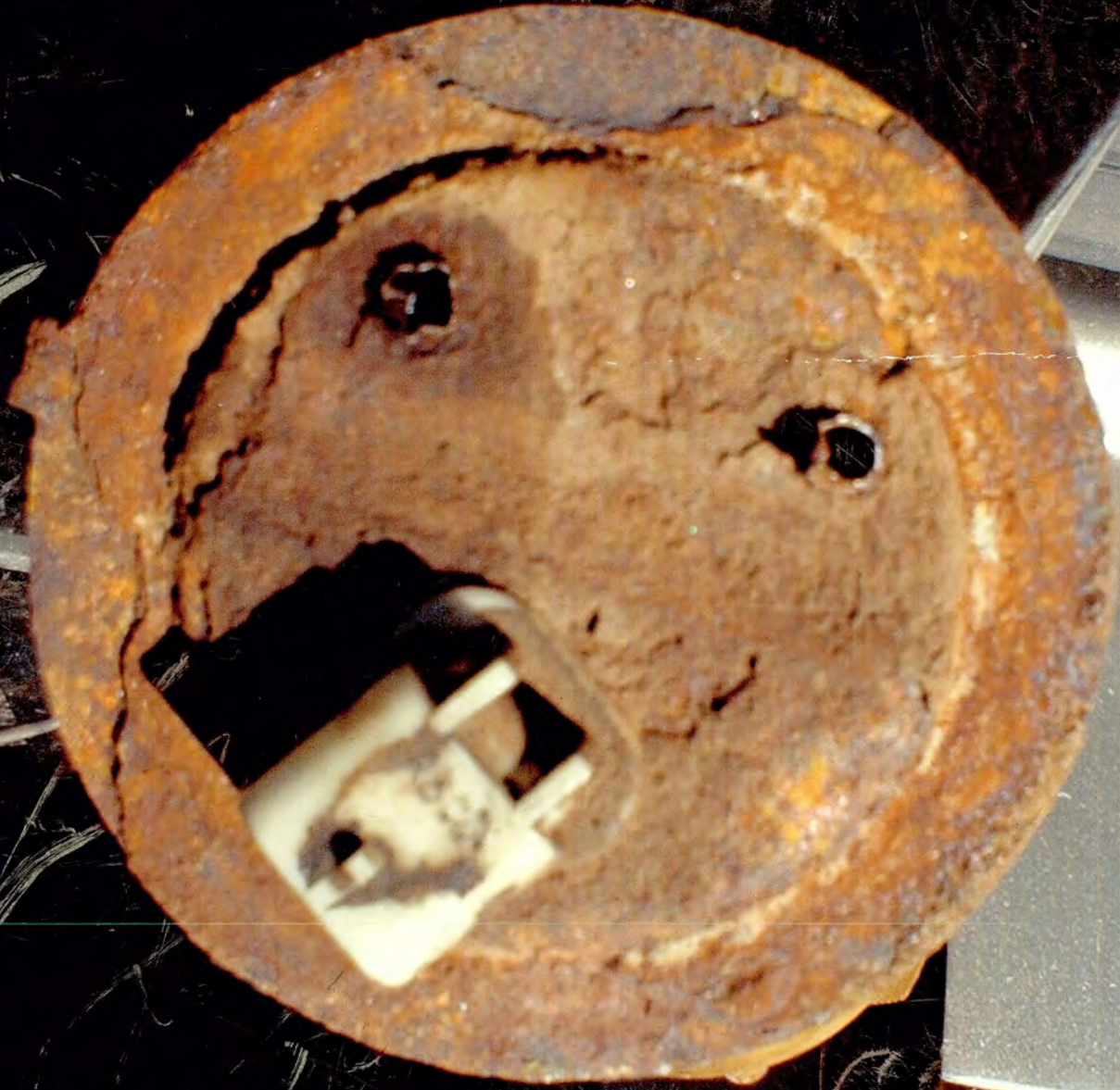
