I have a 2007 Toyota Camry. The car was purchased in 08/21/ 2007. The reason I bought Toyota, was because of Toyota's reputation of reliability and safety. Now the car has 67,220 ml. and all scheduled services have been done at Toyota Authorized dealerships.

After the purchase, I started experiencing problems with the car's safety.

The car's steering wheel shakes. I took the car to numerous authorized dealers but their answer always was the same " We did not find any problems with the steering wheel". I drive the car every day with an unstable steering wheel. This car is my only source of transportation. I drive to work, drop my children to school, and pick them up. I'm concerned for my safety and that of my children. Until now the problem exists and has never been fixed, even though it was taken to the dealership during existing warranty.

In addition, from the time of purchase until now, the tire pressure sensor has been on, and even after being reset at the time of scheduled services it remains on. Toyota authorized dealers reset the sensor and returned my car to me with a flashing tire pressure light stating, " The sensor will disappear after driving a few miles". You (Toyota) put that feature for safety reasons, if it does not work it means my safety and safety of my

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passengers is in jeopardy.

Furthermore, the driver's side sun visor flips down while the car is in motion.

When it flips down my view of the road is obscured. It is safety hazard.

Finally, Toyota replaced my radio a year ago. Now after one year my radio (CD player is not working). The CD player was used in part for educational purposes for my children. The lack of a functioning radio (CD player) causes them to miss out on valuable instructional time during trips to dance lessons, piano and school.

The purpose of this letter is to express my concern for my safety and that of my children.
