<p>TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 1994 CHRYSLER LHS. WITHIN A FEW SECONDS OF PARKING HIS VEHICLE THE CONTACT NOTICED SMOKE COMING FROM THE FRONT END OF THE VEHICLE, THEN HE SAW FLAMES COMING FROM THE UNDERNEATH THE HOOD. HE AND THE PASSENGER GOT OUT OF THE VEHICLE AND RAN AWAY FROM THE VEHICLE. WITHIN A FEW MINUTES, THE FLAMES WERE AT LEAST 30 FEET IN THE AIR. THE FIRE DEPARTMENT ARRIVED WITHIN 5 MINUTES AND THEY EXTINGUISHED THE FIRE WITHIN 15 MINUTES. THE VEHICLE WAS DESTROYED. A POLICE REPORT WAS FILED AND HE WAS NOT SURE IF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT ALSO FILED A REPORT. THE CONTACT HAD SCHEDULED AN APPOINTMENT WITH AN AUTHORIZED DEALER FOR JANUARY 3, 2011 BECAUSE HE HEARD A NOISE COMING FROM THE REAR END OF THE VEHICLE. HE REFERENCED RECALL 98V184000, FUEL SYSTEM, GASOLINE:FUEL INJECTION SYSTEM. HIS PARENTS WERE THE ORIGINAL OWNERS OF THE VEHICLE AND STATED THAT THE RECALL REPAIR WAS NEVER PERFORMED ON THE VEHICLE. THE FAILURE AND CURRENT MILEAGES WERE 145,000.</p>

On 01-02-2011 I was working SPD unit 1G1 in full uniform in a marked police vehicle when I was dispatched to assist SPF with a car fire.

Upon my arrival I was met by V/ [REDACTED] who stated he and his friend (V/ [REDACTED] were driving around meeting friends when they noticed smoke coming from the engine compartment of their vehicle (890-VIT). He went on to state that they pulled over and immediately called the fire department. V/ [REDACTED] then stated both he and his friend walked east bound on E. Columbia St. to get away from the fire. He then stated that he noticed two males following them. V/ [REDACTED] then stated he and his friend ran to Swedish Hospital's Emergency Room for fear that then men were after them.

V/ [REDACTED] stated his friend (V/ [REDACTED] was still at Swedish Hosp.

Officer Wade responded to Swedish Hospital to speak with V/ [REDACTED]. V/ [REDACTED] stated he and his friend (V/ [REDACTED] were driving around when they noticed smoke coming from the engine compartment. He then stated they pulled over and called the fire department. He then stated he noticed three Black/Males following them. V/ [REDACTED] stated he and V/ [REDACTED] ran to Swedish Hospital for fear the three men were after them.

At the scene SPF E25 completed their paperwork and cleared the scene.

Vehicle [REDACTED] received minor damage resulting from its proximity to the fire. The registered owner of vehicle [REDACTED] arrived at the scene and both he and V/ [REDACTED] exchanged info for insurance purposes.

V/ [REDACTED] requested we contact Lincoln Tow for a private tow to his mechanic. Lincoln arrived and removed the vehicle without incident.

I conducted an area check for the three Black / Males with negative results.
