TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2005 NISSAN TITAN. WHILE DRIVING APPROXIMATELY 10 MPH, THE CONTACT STATED THAT HE HEARD A HOWLING NOISE FROM THE REAR OF THE VEHICLE. WHEN HE ATTEMPTED TO CHANGE LANES, THE REAR END LOCKED UP AND SKIDDED ABOUT ONE HUNDRED FEET BEFORE IT STOPPED, CAUSING THE REAR DRIVE AXLE TO POP OFF. THE VEHICLE WAS TOWED TO THE DEALER WHERE THEY PERFORMED A DIAGNOSTIC TEST WHICH CONCLUDED THAT THE REAR END NEEDED TO BE REPLACED. THE MANUFACTURER WAS NOTIFIED WHO INFORMED THE CONTACT THAT HIS VEHICLE WAS NO LONGER UNDER WARRANTY AND OFFERED NO FURTHER ASSISTANCE. THE VEHICLE WAS REPAIRED BY A PRIVATE MECHANIC. THE CURRENT AND FAILURE MILEAGES WERE 106,000.

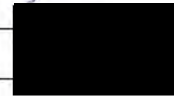
