Hello I have a 2007 base model corvette. I have been dealling with the SAHS problem with my car for about 6 months now. I have replace the SWPS (steering wheel position sensor), the brake switch twice, I have unplugged and replugged everything GM says to do twice. I had the little orange comb that installs into the SWPS harness (the recall the used to try to fix the problem on 05-06 models) adn it still comes on. NOW, I have NOT had the braking problem some have had were the car brakes on it's own. BUT when the SAHS comes on my car (as well as others on the corvetteforum have had it happen) the brake lights stay in the "ON POSTITION" . To day as I was taking it to the dealer ship... AGAIN for the same propblem I almost got rear ended by a car who could not tell if I was braking or not. He when out of control to avoid me. When I asked if he was ok, he explained that he had been following me and could tell if I was braking or not because The lights seamed to be on all the time. I explained that they brake lights had been on all the time and that it was a problem that I was on my way to the dealer to have them look at it. ANYWAY The dealerships dont seam to know what is going on or how to fix the problem. The service writer to day saw the car with the SAHS on the DIC and he also saw the brake light stuck in the "on position:" They still have the car trying to figer it out.
