But when they have to work on the tie pressure sensor look at in 2004 four runner, when it time to leave, I get TAC light and another trouble light come on this happen about 4 times. And I have to turn around until they put a small sensor and run it 25mph. and this problem works when they have a mechanic that knows it. On my last oil change and they check to see if they could shut off the blinking tire pressure light. I left the shop after and the other trouble light came on as I was leaving the shop, didn't even leave parking lot and the trouble light came on back to shop but the door was closed. Drive to the back and the mechanic was changing somebody but he try to fix it but did not know about the little probe sensor so Mark came over and ask if I would come back. This was Friday April 15th 2011 had friend on the weekend so Wednesday I came back the truck was running fine, the mechanic did not have a clue about my problem said I had bad gas or a plug was miss firing. I told them there was no problem driving here expects the trouble light that come on ever time some mechanic works on my truck that does not know what he is doing. And come to find out this only happen on 2004 4-runner. Now the warrantee ran out it's going to be a bigger problem and more money.
