TL* THE CONTACT OWNS A 1999 FORD F150. WHILE DRIVING APPROXIMATELY 10 MPH INTO A DRIVEWAY, A LOUD NOISE EMITTED OUTSIDE OF THE VEHICLE. THE CONTACT TURNED THE ENGINE OFF AND DETECTED BOTH FUEL TANK STRAPS WERE FRACTURED DUE TO RUST. AS A RESULT OF THE FAILURE, THERE WAS A SMALL AMOUNT OF FUEL LEAKAGE ON THE GROUND. THE MANUFACTURER WAS NOTIFIED AND THEY ADVISED THERE WAS NOT A RECALL PERTAINING TO THE DEFECT. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS APPROXIMATELY 146,000.
