

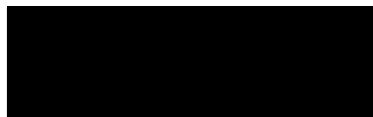

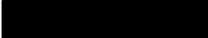

Thank you for your correspondence concerning your Jetzon Innovation tires. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) Office of Defects Investigation (ODI) received your correspondence in our Washington DC office.

NHTSA is the Federal agency responsible for improving safety on our Nation's highways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain safety defects in their design, construction, or performance. We also monitor the adequacy of manufacturers' recall campaigns. In order for the agency to initiate an investigation, we look carefully at the body of consumer complaints and other available data to determine whether a defect may exist. We cannot act on isolated problems or resolve disputes between individual owners, dealers, or manufacturers.

You indicated contacting NHTSA prior to this report. Complaints submitted by owners are automatically entered into the ODI complaint database. If additional information is required, we may follow up by contacting the vehicle owner. We apologize for any confusion this may have caused you. We have reviewed our database in an effort to identify whether a safety defect trend exists with regard to Jetzon Innovation tires, specifically tire separation of the P225/75R15 tires installed on your model year 1978 Cadillac Deville. At this time, there is insufficient evidence to warrant opening a safety defect investigation.

Although there are Jetzon tires recalled we have not initiated a recall on the particular tire equipped on your vehicle. Please keep in mind that recalls are based on a specific make, model and model year of a vehicle; furthermore, can be specific to a particular size of an item of vehicle equipment.
