<p>TL* THE CONTACT OWNS A 2005 CHEVROLET TRAILBLAZER. THE CONTACT STATED THAT WHILE DRIVING APPROXIMATELY 55 MPH, THE VEHICLE STALLED BECAUSE THERE WAS NO FUEL IN THE FUEL TANK. THE CONTACT ALSO STATED THAT PRIOR TO THE FAILURE, THE FUEL GAUGE DISPLAYED A READING INDICATING THAT FUEL WAS PRESENT IN THE FUEL TANK. ROADSIDE ASSISTANCE APPEARED ON THE SCENE TO REFUEL THE VEHICLE AND THE CONTACT WAS ABLE TO CONTINUE DRIVING.
