PROBLEM STARTED AND STILL HAPPENS. RESEARCH ON APRILIA FORUMS SHOW THAT SEVERAL OTHER OWNERS ARE HAVING THE EXACT SAME ISSUE. ENGINE STALLS WHEN DOWNSHIFTING. PROBLEM HAPPENS RAPIDLY, SOMETIMES IT IS NECESSARY TO RESTART ENGINE TWO OR MORE TIMES AS IT KEEPS STALLING.
