Dear Dept. of Transportation:

Enclosed you will find a photo of the Sun Visor that fell off of my daughters 2007 Toyota Camry.

While researching how to get the Visor repaired/replaced, I found that this defective part is a VERY common problem in Toyota Camrys 2007 through 2009. There are many similar stories on the internet.

This is dangerous safety issue, my daughter had a difficult time avoiding a collision as the visor fell down into her lap obstructing her view of oncoming traffic. Additionally, it is dangerous to drive without a visor due to the Sun obstructing the views.

I am hoping that you will investigate this situation and at least recommend that Toyota make changes in order to avoid any more dangerous traffic situations.

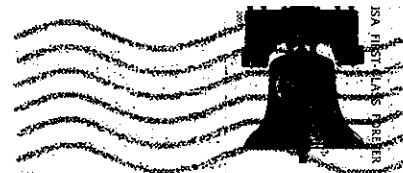
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
