Hope this might keep someone from getting hurt or loose life!

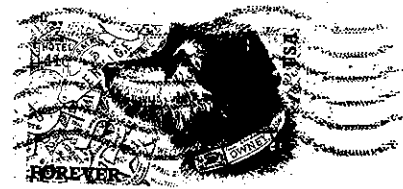
