Going to the GMC forum on the internet tells of many same incidents.

The dealership where we purchased said they would keep our service records - only to sell out to another dealer who wouldn't continue this.

Wiring harness in the extended cab door fails to keep airbag working due to normal use of the door - wiring disconnects after opening & shutting.

Our 2005 Canyon has been well cared for and serviced - looks almost new.

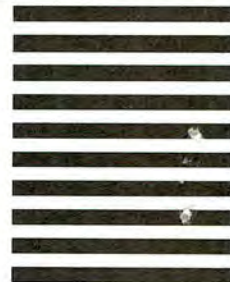
