In reference to ODI ID#10289803 and ODI ID#10445598, please be advised that after having my car (Hyundai Sonata 2006) repaired by a Hyundai dealer (Red Hoagland Hyundai, Inc) in Winter Haven, Florida on 1/31/2012, and being assured by the dealer that the car was repaired, within 150 miles later, the air bag light became illuminated and is still illuminated and therefore making the air bags throughout the vehicle inoperable. I am reporting this to advise that Hyundai has not replaced the defective seat yet, and I want to make the NHTSA aware of this problem.

Please take this matter under advisement and help correct the problem.
