TL* THE CONTACT OWNS A 2009 NISSAN GT-R. THE CONTACT STATED THAT FUEL SPILLED OUT FROM THE FILLER NECK WHILE REFUELING. NEITHER THE DEALER NOR THE MANUFACTURER WERE NOTIFIED OF THE FAILURE. THE VEHICLE WAS NOT DIAGNOSED OR REPAIRED. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 9,300 AND THE CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 10,900.

When filling the vehicle with fuel, after the pump stops a few seconds later fuel begins to pour out of the filler neck. This has occurred to many people not just myself. As can be seen at the following link to an owners club forum:

This happens at multiple pumps at multiple stations, and occurs without trying to top off the tank.

I have since called Nissan and they said they are aware of the situation and have ordered a new fuel tank for my vehicle.
