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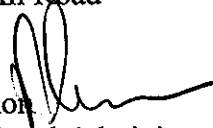

Gentlemen,

This letter is to inform you of safety defects with our 2003 Audi All Road.

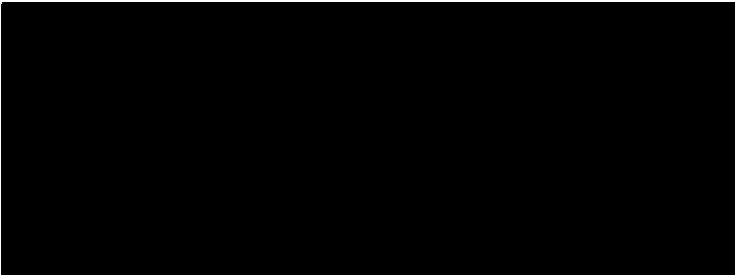
1 - Transmission operation.

At times, the transmission does not react to a sudden depression of the gas pedal. The resulting delay in acceleration could result in a collision due to the inability to move the car in a timely manner.

2 - The drivers seat belt does not retract. This condition has gone on for a number of years.

3 - Wheels - We have experienced multiple flat tires (at least 5). The cause is wheel corrosion resulting in a loss of the air seal between wheels and tires.

Please review the above with the intent of determining if a recall is warranted.
