THE SECOND TRY. I NEVER INQUIRED ABOUT THE PROBLEM.

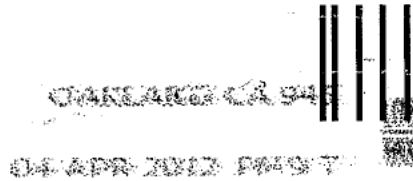
