THE WAS VEHICLE WAS NOT TAKEN TO THE DEALER. THE MANUFACTURE WAS NOTIFIED AND STATED THAT THE VEHICLE WAS NOT UNDER THE RECALL ASSOCIATED WITH NHTSA CAMPAIGN ID NUMBER 00V122000 (SEAT BELTS:FRONT:WEBBING). THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 95,000 AND THE CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 103,000.

Owner purchased Seatbelt & installed by owner after injury/failure. Drivers seatbelt is frayed & fails to restrain driver at present. 2nd belt for Drivers side is needed now. Requesting Reimbursement for 2 seat belts.
