it will spray out the neck without the Nozel inserted too

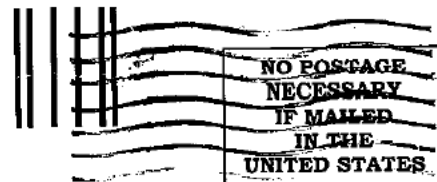
