I contacted the Ford Corp. Safety Recall ended in the middle of the year. Vehicles are still out there and are not covered.

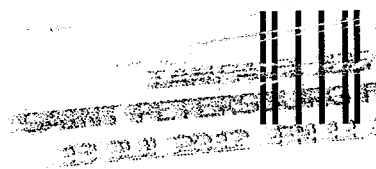

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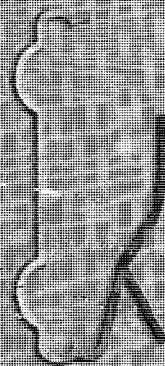
