TL* THE CONTACT OWNS A 2006 HYUNDAI SONATA. THE CONTACT STATED THAT RECALL NHTSA CAMPAIGN ID NUMBER: 09V122000 (SERVICE BRAKES: HYDRAULIC; SWITCHES: BRAKE LIGHTS) WAS PERFORMED ON THE VEHICLE IN 2009 AND THE REPAIRS FAILED. THE CONTACT STATED WHEN DRIVING THE VEHICLE THE ELECTRONIC STABILIZER CONTROL LIGHT ILLUMINATED AND THE VEHICLE HAD TO BE RESTARTED IN ORDER FOR IT TO TURN OFF. THE CONTACT STATED THAT AFTER DRIVING FOR A SHORT PERIOD OF TIME THE FAILURE WOULD RECUR. THE VEHICLE HAD NOT BEEN INSPECTED, BUT A MECHANIC TOLD THE CONTACT THAT THEY BELIEVE THE FAILURE WAS CAUSED BY THE STOMP LAMP SWITCH FAILING AGAIN. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS UNKNOWN AND THE CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 86,000.
