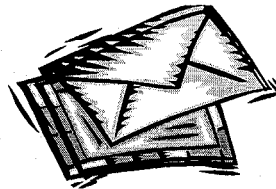

Good afternoon Jennifer,

We are requesting, again, an update on what is or is not happening with our request for the Senator's intervention into the CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES, test cases, in foreclosure as well as the issue of FORD MOTOR COMPANY'S UNSAFE 2005 TAURUS AUTOMOBILES AND THE FAILURE TO ACT BY THE FEDERAL OVERSIGHT AGENCY/DEPARTMENT, NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY. They have over 500 complaints on this vehicle and over 90 of that is on the very serious and unsafe transmission problems.

Do we need to die or be seriously injured before the Legislator and or the Oversight Agency intervene to protect the consumer/constituents?

Reports show that General Motors and the NHTS oversight was aware and had been aware of the serious problems that has now caused injuries and deaths.

Ford Motor Company as well as the Oversight Agency, NHTS, is and has been aware of the, it appears, serious unsafe problems with the 2005 Ford Taurus.

Ford is taking consumer to court for a vehicle they certified too dangerous to drive when the fault, it appears, is their own faulty design and failure to correct the problems. (documented) No transmission should go out/fail, become too unsafe to drive, under 50,000, miles twice. If they had corrected the problem, put a new transmission in, when it first happened rather than do patch work on the failed one the problems may have been resolved for many consumers.

We need a response from the Senator.

Now the oversight agency/department, Ford Motor, Ford Credit and Capitol Expressway Ford, the dealership, it appears, is not the only ones with knowledge of the danger, unsafe vehicle, but failing to act.
