Dear sir,

I have a 2008 Toyota Yaris, and it has an unusual headlight system. When the automobile is turned on with the lights turned off, the instrument panel is brightly lit up. When the headlights are turned on, the instrument panel goes dim. This is backwards.

I believe this is a poor design. During dusk, the driver needs to know the lights are on, and a dark instrument panel indicates to the driver the headlights are turned off. Normally, the driver in poor light or dark conditions starts the automobile, and the dark instrument panel lets the driver know to run on the lights.

The Yaris does not do this, I believe the lighting system should be reversed.
