Re: Toyota Scion model year 2006 (Camry engine) sudden acceleration.

Dear Sir:

This letter is to inform you that on Saturday February 26 2011 at 12:45 pm my 2006 Toyota Scion suddenly accelerated, and I was seriously and permanently injured. The car was demolished. A Toyota employee examined the car and said he could get no information from the Black Box because it was destroyed in the crash.

My Scion was stopped at the exit to the parking lot of Ridgewood Savings Bank in Queens County NYC when car suddenly accelerated at full-speed-ahead, crossing Forest Ave and striking a brick wall head-on. I struck a woman who sustained a broken knee.

I am crippled for the rest of my life. I was taken to the hospital unconscious, with a broken right hip, broken right heel, concussion, cuts and bruises. I have endured 4 operations, and I must use a walker to get around.

Up until the time of the accident I was very active every day. I was employed part-time as a full-charge bookkeeper, but I am no longer able to work. I did yoga a couple times a week and did volunteer work. All this is no longer possible because of the accident.

I have always been a safe driver. My home is in the City of New York, but because of my weak physical condition I am staying with relatives in Tennessee. The reason I have not reported this crash sooner is because my priority has been attempting to be able to walk.

Owning a Toyota Scion has ruined my life.
