THE MANUFACTURER WAS CONTACTED ABOUT THE FAILURE AND INFORMED THE CONTACT THAT THE VEHICLE WAS NOT INCLUDED IN NHTSA CAMPAIGN NUMBER: 95V244000 (FUEL SYSTEM, -GASOLINE). THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS APPROXIMATELY 128,000. THE VIN WAS NOT AVAILABLE.

Narrative Description of Incident(s), Failure(s), Crash(es), and Injury(ies)

I brought car in to Mario Daddario of Shelton, CT for Recall Fuel tank Assembly Pipe Filler Neck. Significant corrosion of the Fuel Filler tube may result in fuel leaks which in the presence of an ignition source could result in a fire. The left rear seat belt retractor is mounted to the wheel housing and in the event of significant corrosion and the mounting could fail in a vehicle crash. Mario Daddario of Shelton, CT did no recall repairs and kept my car until I paid \$122.88.

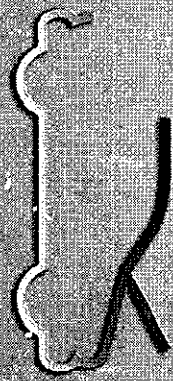
