You need to remove 4 hoses and 2 electrical connectors from the canister before pulling it out. If you live in the north, road salt causes a lot of rusting on the brackets and bolts adding to the difficulty in removal of the bolts and hoses and connectors. 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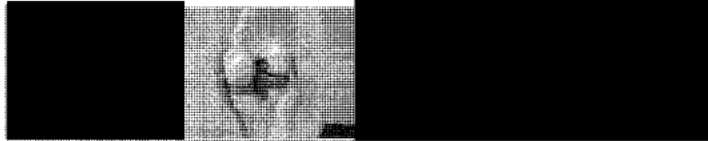
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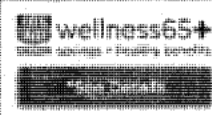

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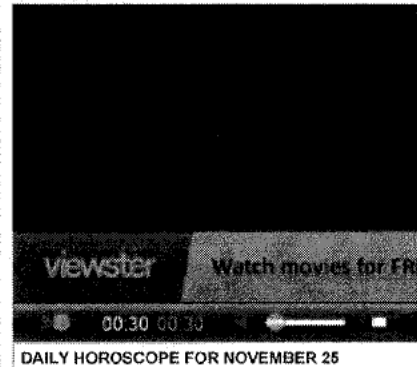

I think as I got going the pulley would wobble thus causing the rattle... it was very annoying... but that was the only rattle that I have experienced... give it a look see. As far as the vapor canister... well... my car is still running fine... it takes fuel ok... Same old story here. 2002 Chevy Prizm. Signs of failure from the evaporative emission system in the form of a check engine light and P441 code and then a P446. Never got the P441 again but the P446 kept coming back. [Mechanics](#) reset the computer a few times (didn't charge me, fortunately) but finally the problems were getting too obvious in terms of engine lag, poor performance at low RPM, stalling, evidence of loss of fuel by evaporation when parked in the open on a hot day, and questionable fuel mileage. Just had it done at my mechanic here -- total parts and labor about \$360, mostly for the part as it's less than an hour of labor -- and quite honestly the car's performance under load is better than it has been since it was just a few months old. Another mechanic in town, who I passed on because although they're great on diagnostics they gave me a ridiculous quote on the part, said to absolutely NOT top the gas tank off as this floods the canister and damages it. With the repair done, I find myself able to run in fourth gear at a lower speed than before, and the compressor no longer makes a fizzing sound at low engine RPM under load when running the air conditioning. 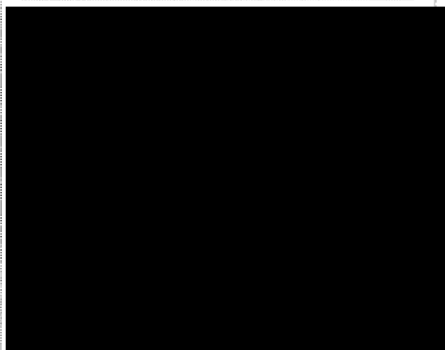

I don't see where the gas cap AND the canister would go bad at the same time. Why not just go buy a new gas cap on your own, about \$20 at a Toyota parts counter. Check the sealing surface of the filler pipe lip for corrosion before putting the new cap on. If it isn't nice and smooth, try rubbing it with very fine sandpaper and put a thin coating of vaseline on the lip of the filler neck. Yes. These cars are very picky about gassing up. Never gas up with the engine running. Never top it off...as soon as the nozzle kicks off, that's it. Don't put another drop in. Probably wouldn't hurt to pick up a new gas cap, as it may have been dropped a few times. Get one from Toyota, not a "fitz-all" from an auto parts place. And make sure you tighten the cap at least a few "clicks".

While you're at all this, have a shop (NOT dealer) check the filler neck for corrosion, another common Toyota problem. Maybe put a coating of heavy grease around the fill pipe.

Do all this and I'll bet you'll be fine. My Camry is.

I go to Auto Zone, get the diagnostic codes, do some internet research, and then after checking the gas cap just unplug the battery. It resets and doesn't go off for another 2 months until February 2011.

Then, seeing this may be a persistent problem, I take it to my independent repair shop that isolates the fault to crack at canister switching valve on charcoal canister. Says that the valve isn't available separately, this is a common Toyota problem - sometimes caused from overfilling the gas tank (which I am guilty of), and it will cost me \$580 parts and labor (after spending \$140 on the diagnosis). Luckily, the part couldn't be ordered and I needed my car to drive today.

So, I am going to try the old fill up the tank 3/4 of the way for a few cycles and see if that has any affect. I may even look at trying to order the part and do this myself (don't know that I want to get into removing the muffler). But luckily I have time (inspection sticker isn't due until September) and can think through what I want to do and how I want to approach this.

I live in a road-salt weather area and rust could be an issue - but I paid for the rusting undercoating - so if that is the case - that is a scam too!

I have 2009 Corolla with 45000+ miles and same thing. Was told I had my EVAP system full of water. The Toyota dealership said it was definitely water, not fuel in it. They want almost \$600 to replace it. I will be writing to Toyota since this seems to be a pretty common problem with their vehicles going back to the 1990's. Apparently, it is a fairly easy fix to do it yourself, but the part itself still costs almost \$300. I think it is defective since I don't live in a flood zone and have never had my car exposed to more water than routine driving in the rain. How water got in there is beyond me.

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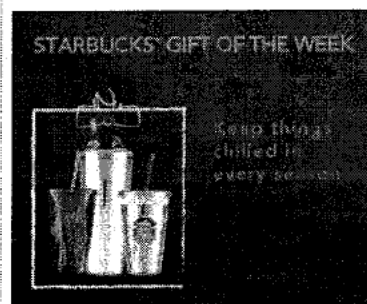

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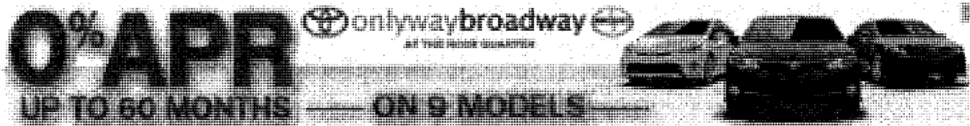

Then had to drive it for a while, to get the computer to update all its tests with new sensor readings. There was no check engine light, so I took it in and it passed the inspection.
