Dear Representative Schwartz,

I spoke to someone at Tom Murt's office and they said to talk to you. I own a 2005 Trailblazer, I bought in 2007. In 2013 I began to have a problem with my speedometer going wild. I contacted dealers and called GM direct and was told there was no recall on this item. I found out there was a class action suit against GM for this issue on about 8 GM vehicles, but of course not my Trailblazer.

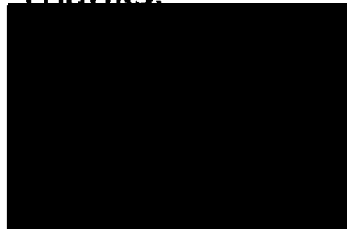
GM said the government has to feel this is an issue to get a recall. I went on-line and there are many people with Trailblazers having this problem. There are many solutions, but all cost between \$250.00 and \$400.00 dollars. I don't have the money for this and this is a GM problem.

A temporary fix is to disconnect the negative battery cable, which I have been doing. This sometimes lasts weeks or only days. It is very frustrating to not know how fast you are

going. This is also a safety issue. I think it needs to be fixed for inspection, which for me is not until October. I hope you can help me get this fixed or direct me to where this issue can be solved.

I have enclosed copies of all my crazy paperwork.
