On July 13, 2013, I parked my '99 Subaru Legacy Outback, 30<sup>th</sup> LTD Edition, in front of Dunkin' Donuts at the mini-mall on N. State Rd., Briarcliff Manor, N.Y.

I parked front end facing the curb, and in order to check the new Halogen Bulbs that were installed in my front beams, after I put the car in park, I exited leaving the keys in so I could check these lights.

When I returned to remove the keys, while the door was open, the car began to roll backwards, and the open door pushed me to the ground.

I had carefully checked that the car was securely in park before I exited to check the lights, and did not touch anything when I returned, and suddenly my car began to roll backwards.

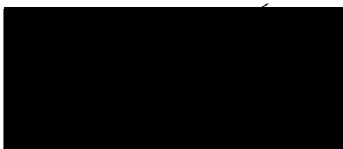
I was subsequently taken to the hospital by ambulance suffering severe head, back, and neck injuries and spent 2 days in hospital. I am still suffering and being medically treated, and in Physical Therapy, for these injuries up to this time.

My car rolled into two other parked cars and caused damage to the cars, and my car had more than \$3,000 of body damage.

Please let me have your advises as to what is the problem that caused my car to roll backward on its own, and how it can be repaired.

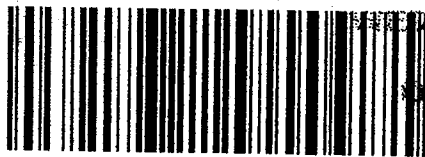

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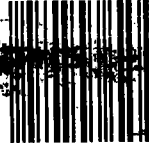


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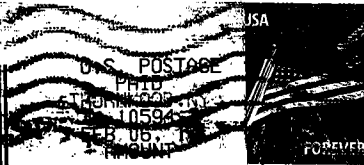
