In my original complaint, I included some incorrect information in regards to the timing of our ignition failure. Here are the correct approx. dates:

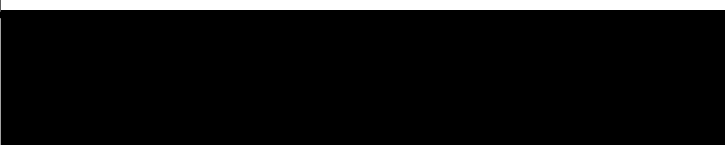
Summer	2005 (still under warrantee)

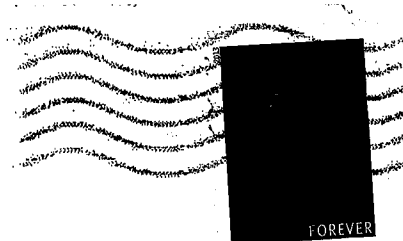
