therapy at Hampshire Hospital. Very disappointed in safety features of that
auto. Car was bought for salvage.

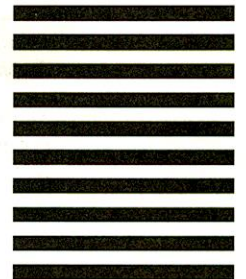
