THE AIR BAGS DID NOT DEPLOY AND THE CONTACT WAS KNOCKED UNCONSCIOUS. THE PASSENGER ALSO SUSTAINED MINOR INJURIES. BOTH THE DRIVER AND PASSENGER REQUIRED MEDICAL ATTENTION. 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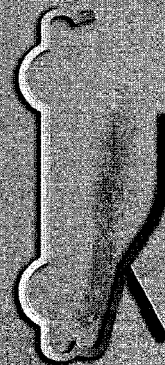
