We are owners of a 2010 Allegro motorhome manufactured by Tiffin Motorhomes, Inc. We received a notice that a defect existed in the clearance lights on our unit. The clearance lights were manufactured by Command Electronics, Inc. The notice stated that the "lights are not sealed well enough to prevent moisture from getting in the light" and that "If moisture gets into the light, it can short out 2 connections that are too close together. This could pose a potential fire hazard."

The proposed corrective action is to insert fuses in the wiring to the lights. While this may reduce the potential of fire hazard, the proposed solution does not correct the manufacturer's defective light and may result in a fire and most probably will result in the loss of the clearance lights.

Please review this problem and issue a new directive requiring the manufacturer of the lights, Command Electronics, Inc., to replace the defective lights with new lights that are properly designed.

The notice states "Command Electronics, Inc. has since redesigned the lights by moving the connections further apart and sealing the lights more securely." Since new designed lights are available, the installation of fuses in the wiring harness is not necessary and only creates a weak link in the weather exposed wiring harness.

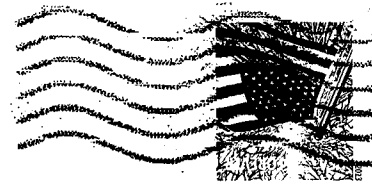
