I feel you should rectify this situation.

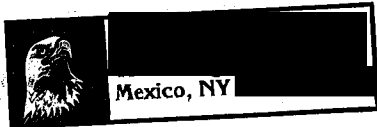

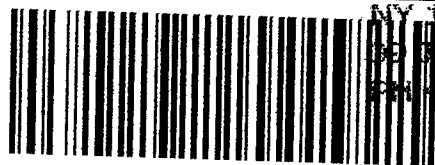

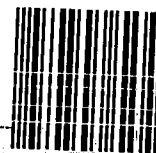
