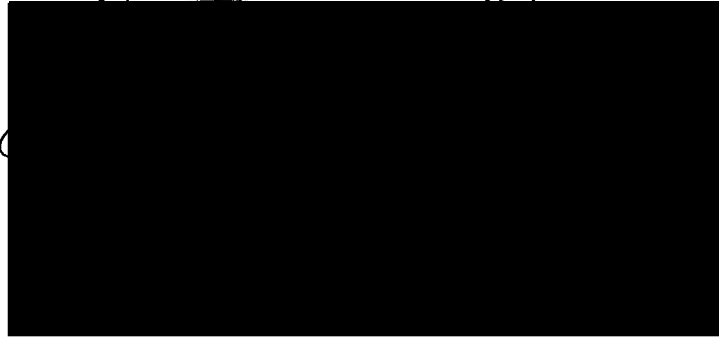

My name is [REDACTED]. In late 2006 , I purchased a new Pontiac Solstice VIN # 1G2MB33BX6Y [REDACTED]. At 33,800 miles the service airbag warning light suddenly came on and indicated an off condition for the passenger seat , even with an adult passenger seated . I filed a complaint with you on 7/31/2014 ODI # 10617967 . This identical problem has been reported by many Solstice & Sky owners. I took the Solstice to St Johnsbury Auto , an authorized General Motors dealer , they diagnosed the problem to be the seat sensor and estimated the repair to be \$ 838.32 . Although this is a very serious safety issue , General Motors has refused to pay for the repair . In light of the very serious nature of the problem , I have a hard time understanding why your agency has not required a safety recall . Please do something before a death occurs .

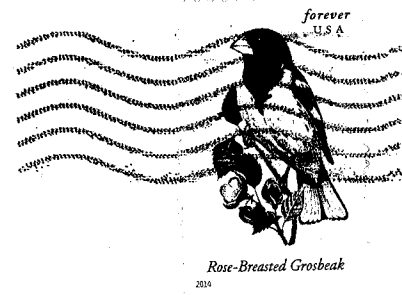
