I am advised per the second page of this letter to forward to your company as I have a Loan (Lessor) with your company. Per the letter they are "Concern About Safety" however the parts are not currently available and they do not state when. This is not showing "Concern About Safety". This recall is being recalled and the issue can cause "DEATH" as this can cause a fire while myself and my child are in the car. I would like to know what actions can be taken as this point!

I am concern as my ignition switch feels very warm and the engine light keeps coming on my dash board (and there is no problems with my engine or any other matters to make reason for this to keep appearing and disappearing)

Since I have a loan/lessor with the Chevo Aveo if my car goes on fire due to this recall what then happens with the loan on this car. I assume as a consumer I am not responsible for this as this is the neglect of Chevrolet.

As there is no detail on when the parts and location for the car to be fixed I will be consulting a Lawyer with regards to this letter from Chevrolet.

Please understand this is a concern for the safety of myself and my child while driving this car.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

General Motors has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists 2006 model year Chevrolet Aveo vehicles. As a result, GM is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for this inconvenience. However, we are concerned about your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.

IMPORTANT

- This notice applies to your 2006 model year Chevrolet Aveo, VIN KL1TG666X6B [REDACTED]
- Your vehicle is involved in GM safety recall 14093.

Why is your vehicle being recalled?

Heat generated within the headlamp switch or daytime running lamp (DRL) module, which are both located on or near the left side of the steering column, could melt the headlamp switch or DRL module and cause a fire.

What will we do?



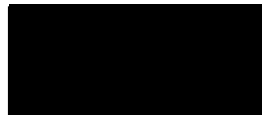
