THE VEHICLE WAS TAKEN TO AN INDEPENDENT MECHANIC WHO DISCOVERED THAT NAILS USED TO CONSTRUCT THE KITCHEN AREA IN THE MOTOR HOME WERE TOO LONG AND CREATED EXPOSED SHARP POINTS THAT PUNCTURED THE PROPANE FUEL LINES TO THE GAS STOVE. THE FAILURE WAS REPAIRED. THE MANUFACTURER WAS NOT NOTIFIED OF THE FAILURE. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 70,000.

The leaking Gas line was caused by defect in cabinet structure that nails ~~it~~ protruding in space where rubber Gas line would move in + out with Slide out. The nails constantly rubbing on hose punctured Hose & created a "very" hazard situation when stove or other propane was on it ^{ATTACH ADDITIONAL SHEETS IF NECESSARY} allowed gas to escape into cabinet area next to where the propane stove is located!!! Not Good!!

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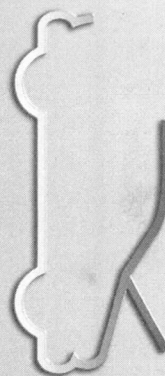
