the ignition switch safety issue.

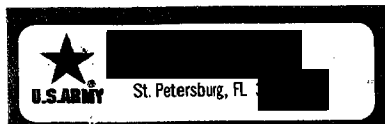
I would first like to say I am

this month because the road I take

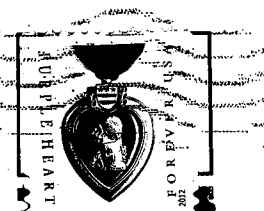
